2019 NC Triangle Chinese Story Telling Sunday, May 5th, 2019 2pm-5pm

I. General Rules and Regulations

- 1. Participants are required to fulfil the registration form via online.
- 2. The contest will be held on Sunday, May 5th 2019, in Fo Quang Shan Temple, Raleigh.
- Participants must fulfil the attendance list on the registration desk before
 1:30pm on the day of contest
- 4. Participants must commit to come on time and follow the fixed schedule given by the committee.

II. Eligibility

- 1. Participants are students of 5 Chinese Language Schools in Triangle area of North Carolina.
- 2. Participants must be able to speak Chinese.
- 3. The contest will be separated into 5 groups: elementary school level I (1^{st} - 3^{rd} grade), elementary school level II (4^{th} 5^{th} grade), middle school level (6^{th} - 8^{th} grade), high school level (9^{th} 12^{th} grade), and non-native Chinese speakers.
- 4. Each Chinese language School may delegate maximally 2 students for each group.

III. Format of Story Telling

- 1. Each contestant is required to choose one of these following topics for their performance.
- 2. Genres that may be used are historical Chinese tales and culture, family story, good behavior, and environment protection and recycling.
- 3. The contestants must prepare 7 copies of the script completed with self-identity, including full name. These documents are submitted on the registration
- 4. The order of performance will be randomly drawn.
- 5. The presentation of the story must be delivered using Chinese/Mandarin.
- 6. Contestants will have 2 to 4 minutes for the presentation of the story.
- 7. Time will start when the contestant first speaks.
- 8. The judge will signal time to the participants using flags:
 - Yellow flag: the storytelling has been performed for 3 minutes
 - Red flag: the time is up (4 minutes = maximum time)
- 9. 15 seconds will be given as a grace period after the 4th minutes. If the story has not been finished yet, the judge will give 5 knocks to signal time is up.

- 10. The grace period will affect the score; every second past the tolerance time will reduce the score by 1 point.
- 11. The winners will be announced in the end of the contest and the prize will be given directly. Each group will have the following winners:

a. 1st Place: \$75 gift card and gold medal

b. 2nd Place: \$50 gift card and silver medal

c. 3rd place: \$25 gift card and bronze medal

12. All participant will receive participation prize after the contest.

IV. System of Assessment

- 1. Each Chinese school will provide one judge for this contest in addition to the judge from co-sponsor Fo Quang Shan.
- 2. The winners will be chosen according to the highest score from all judges (minus the highest and lowest score). The criterion are:
 - a. Method (structure, organization of story)/Content (Plot) (30%)
 - b. Pronunciation/Intonation Accuracy/Grammar (40%)
 - c. Manner(attitude)/Performance (30%)
