



Transfer Credit for Local Chinese Language Schools

In alignment with the current Wake County Public School System Policy regarding transfer credit, and in discussion with Mary Ellen Taft, High School Counseling Coordinator, the following statements are considered best practices for WCPSS students enrolled in local Chinese language (Saturday) schools.

Based on documentation provided by the principals of the Raleigh Academy of Chinese Language and the NC Raleigh Chinese Language School:

1. Upon completion of the *appropriate level, including a transcript, award one credit of Second Language Chinese I (10462A) and Second Language Chinese II (10472A), with grade of Pass/Fail.
2. It is the responsibility of each school to send a copy of the student's transcripts in English to the Dean of Student Services at the individual high school, and one copy to the High School Counseling Coordinator at Central Services.
3. Regardless of credit awarded, students entering the Chinese program in WCPSS will be subject to a Chinese language exam for appropriate placement.

Notes:

Appropriate level to earn two units of Chinese credit in WCPSS:

Raleigh Academy of Chinese Language—successful completion of Grade/Level III

NC Raleigh Chinese Language School—successful completion of Middle School, grade 8

It is recommended to attach a final transcript from the Chinese language school to our WCPSS final transcript when students are applying to post-secondary institutions.
